Founder of Hazon, the largest environmental organization in the American Jewish community, creating healthy and sustainable communities in the Jewish world and beyond.

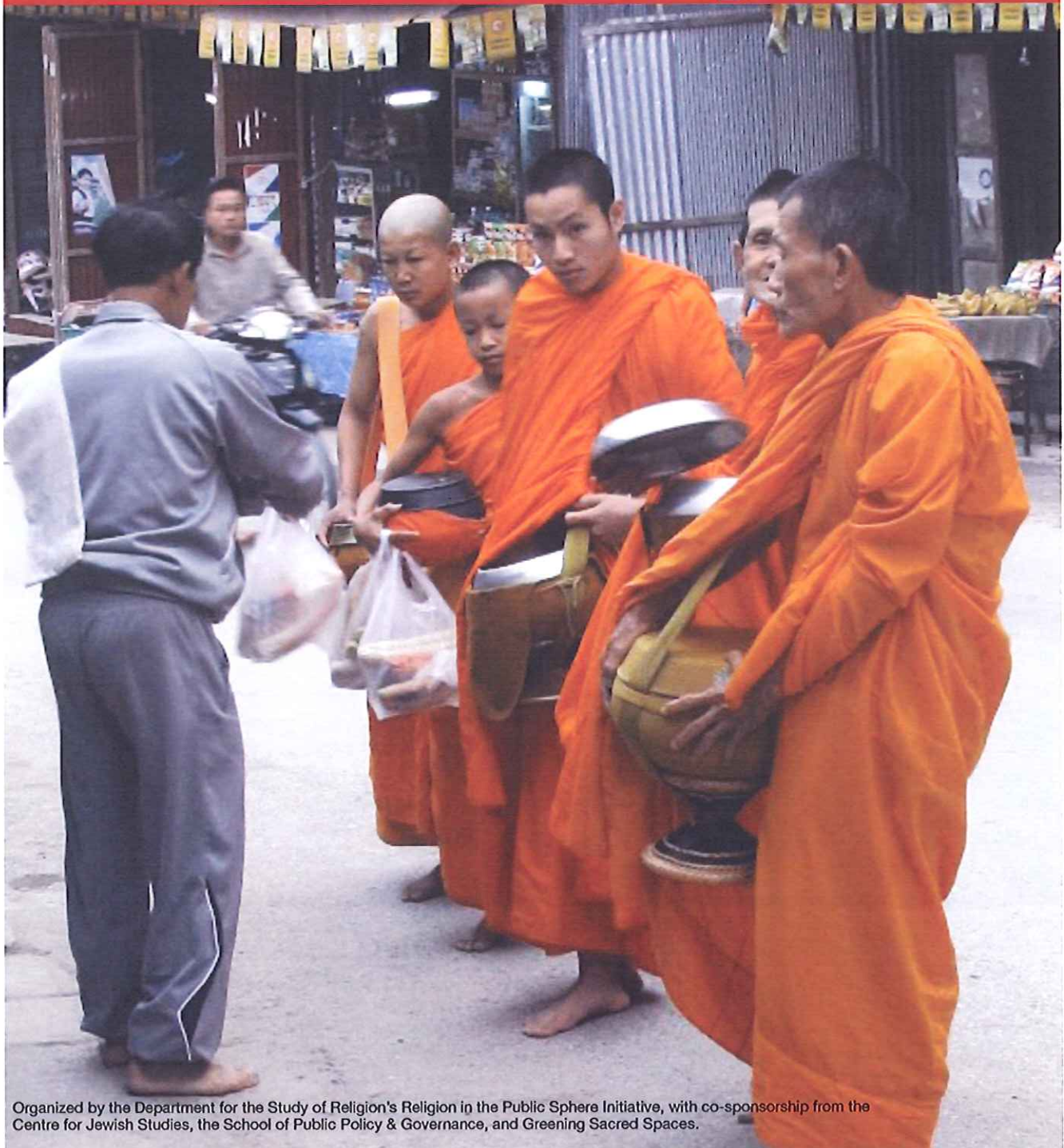


**Elbert van Donkersgoed**
